This class will provide an overview of the main statutory law governing dependency cases, including CAPTA, ASFA, ICWA and Fostering Connections, among others. It will also review recent court decisions, including the recent controversial case out of Texas finding that ICWA is unconstitutional. (This class will not cover Family First Prevention Services Act of 2018 – that will be a separate CLE). This class follows the format of a popular TV game show, allowing for attendees to test their knowledge while learning about recent developments out of federal courts.
