Beyond the Basics: Advanced Training in Representing LGBTQ Clients in Foster Care

What: You've been to LGBTQ trainings before. You know the differences between a cisgender pansexual man and an MTF bisexual woman. You know LGBTQ clients have the right to be respected for who they are. We'll teach you how to enforce that right.

This training is intended for attorneys who represent clients in foster care and who have already received introductory training on LGBTQ issues. We will skip the "basics" and move directly to specific legal techniques that can be used to further clients' interests on LGBTQ issues. Topics will include obtaining appropriate placements for LGBTQ youth, obtaining hormone treatment for transgender youth, CCSD policies regarding gender diverse students, and incorporating LGBTQ programs into case plans.
